□ Isolate at home for 5 days ¹

As much as possible:

- □ Stay in a specific room away from other people and pets in the home
- Use a separate bathroom
- U Wear a mask around other people in the home

After 5 Days IF YOU ARE NOT EXPERIENCING SYMPTOMS OR SYMPTOMS ARE RESOLVING AND YOU ARE FEVER FREE FOR 24 HOURS \rightarrow

□ You may leave your house

□ Must wear a mask while around others during Days 6 through 10
